Subject: Oil Spill Containment, Cleanup, and Wetland Intrusion Prevention

We are very disheartened to see the catastrophic amounts of oil that has been released from this tragic spill. We feel that not responding to our previous letters has potentially resulted in the increased severity of the spill. We feel this way due to my memory of my previous oil spill and containment conceptions in the past and the lack of conceptions by anyone else. My company policy is that you will always save money, and in this case ecological damages, by contracting with us. The savings would be 85% of your total spill cleanup obligation. This gives us 15% which is our standard policy. Clearly your policy of refusing to pay for good ideas, in this instance, has the potential or certainty of costing your company its entire net worth. Our company has no tangible cash asset reserves to accomplish research and development so we are partnering directly with companies due to our precarious financial position. Due to other factors, such as the uncertainty of being awarded a patent on anything we design and the subsequent competition from copy cats and patent frauds, we have to take the position of placing funds in court supervised accounts, subject to payments from contracts and payments based on immediate check of internet availability of the improvement. Due to espionage potential, we also require a ten day preparation period that excludes duplicate filings. These are the only methods we have been able to devise to ensure correct inventor payment. Please contact us at your earliest convenience as the hurricane season is progressing with shine oil wetland contaminations becoming a large scale ecological disaster consideration.
